

# Instructions

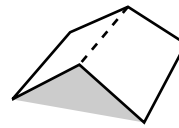
You will need a craft knife or other sharp knife, a pair of scissors, some glue and a glue spreader.

The best type of glue to use is white school glue (PVA.)

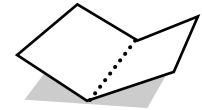
Print out the parts sheets onto thin cardboard. Photocopier card is ideal. Notice that the parts pages are marked front and back. Print out a front page, flip it over, then print the back onto the same sheet. Leave the ink to dry completely before continuing.

Before cutting anything out, score along all the dotted lines and cut out any holes with a craft knife. Both these jobs are easier to do on full sheets of card.

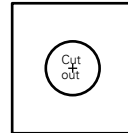
Dashed lines are hill folds, dotted lines are valley folds. Cut along the solid lines. Grey areas show where to glue



Dashed lines are hill folds



Dotted lines are valley folds

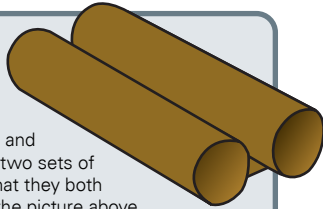


Black lines show where to cut.



Shaded areas show where to glue.

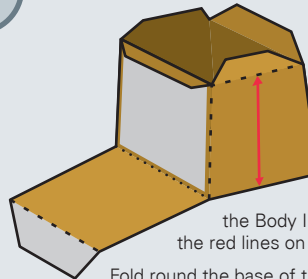

Carefully roll round and glue the two sets of legs so that they both look like the picture above. (1-4)

The edge of the legs line up with the grey line, however make sure that the grey line is on the outside of the leg tube.

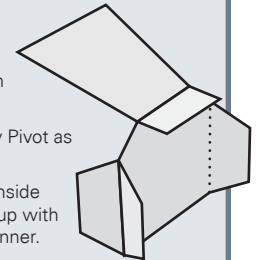


Glue the first flap on the Body Inner. (5).

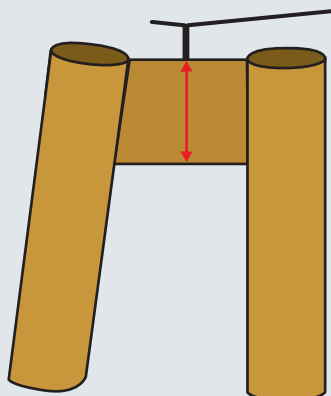
Assemble the Body Pivot as shown right (6).

Glue the Body Pivot inside the Body Inner. (7 and 8) Line it up with the red lines on the side of the Body Inner.

Fold round the base of the Body Inner and glue it into place. (9-10)



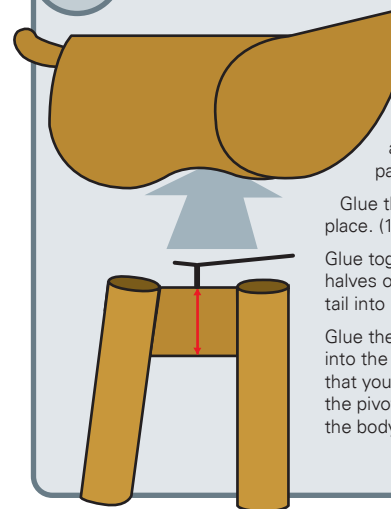

Glue the two sets of legs to the body inner. (11-12)

Let the glue dry thoroughly.

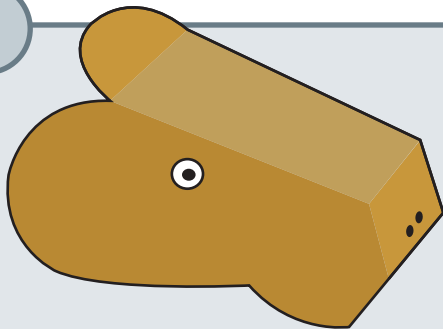
Glue the neck to the body using the grey areas to line up the parts. (13-15)

Glue the bottom into place. (16-18)

Glue together the two halves of the tail. Glue the tail into place (19)

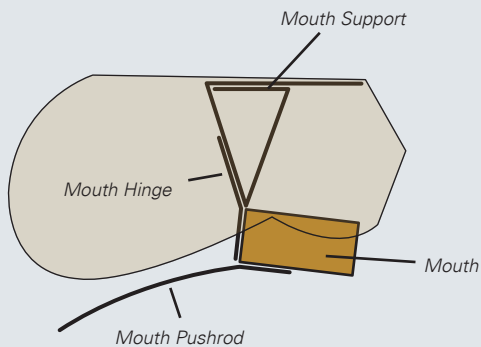
Glue the legs assembly into the body. Make sure that you line up the front of the pivot with the front of the body. (16)

Glue together the head following the numbers 20 and 21.

Fold round and glue together the Mouth Support. (22)

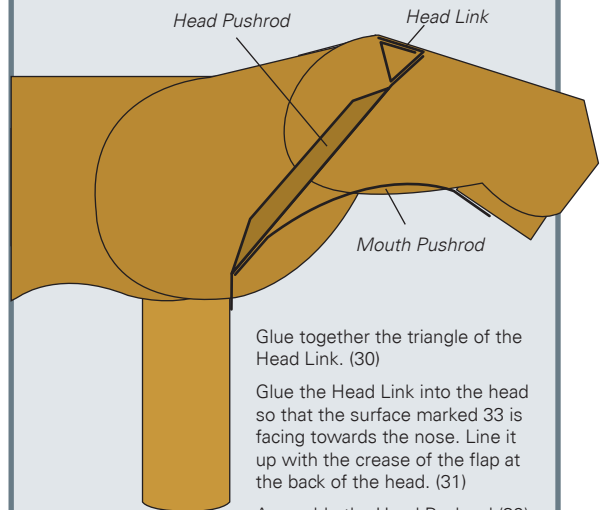
Make up the mouth so that it looks like a small shallow tray. (23-25)

Glue the mouth to the Mouth Support using the Mouth Hinge. (26-27)

Glue the Mouth Pushrod into place on the bottom of the mouth. (28)

Once the glue is dry, glue the entire mouth assembly inside the head. (29) Line up the end of the Mouth Support with the front of the head as shown in the diagram above.

Glue together the triangle of the Head Link. (30)

Glue the Head Link into the head so that the surface marked 33 is facing towards the nose. Line it up with the crease of the flap at the back of the head. (31)

Assemble the Head Pushrod (32)

Glue the Head Pushrod to the Head Link. (33)

Glue the Head into place. (34)

Glue the Head Pushrod to the front of the Legs. (35)

Glue the Mouth Pushrod to the Head Pushrod. (36)



Finish off by gluing on the antlers and the ears.

Let the model dry thoroughly. Your Paper Moose is now complete. Rock the body to make him work.
